Spotlight on Uniform Regulations

Students are required to attend each class wearing the correct class uniform. Teachers will allow a few minutes in between lessons for students to change.

Ballet Leotards and tights will not be accepted in Modern, Tap or Jazz Classes.

Hair must also be dressed appropriately for class from Pre Primary to Advanced 2

Ballet – Classical Bun or hairband for short hair.

Modern, Tap, Jazz – Hair to be tied neatly off the face in a bun, ponytail, plaits, or a hairband for short hair.

All uniform for ballet including beginners, Pre-Primary & Primary should be RAD uniform only.

Students should remove earrings and any jewellery before class.

Students may also wear AASD branded uniform in Class as a warmup item during the colder months. Teacher's will advise students when it is the appropriate time to remove warm up clothing.

Miss Laura will be teaching Saturday Ballet Classes at KPs and private lessons.



After graduating from the Northern Ballet School in 2022, Laura completed a Professional Graduate Diploma in Modern Ballet at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland in Partnership with Scottish Ballet. Since completing the Diploma in July 2023, Laura has danced professionally with Alvin Ailey and with the International Festival Ballet

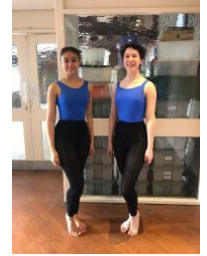
